

Board of Directors Nominations

Aurora Chamber's Mission: The Aurora Regional Chamber of Commerce — a membership-driven organization — shall serve as a catalyst for business development in the greater Aurora region.

A Board of Directors governs the business, property, and affairs of the Aurora Regional Chamber of Commerce. The Board is responsible for establishing policy, budgets, and the guidance of affairs. The Board is composed of up to twenty-two (22) persons who shall be members in good standing of the Chamber. Directors are elected for a term of three (3) years which are staggered so that approximately one-third of the directors are elected each year. Vacancies in the board shall be filled by a majority vote of the remaining directors.

The Aurora Regional Chamber of Commerce is seeking nominations for members willing to be considered to serve on the Board of Directors. All eligible nominees will be considered by the nominating committee. Nominations may be sent to Aurora Regional Chamber of Commerce, attention: Joseph Henning, IOM, CAE, ACE.
